Esta semana ídes ter dous tipos de tarefas:

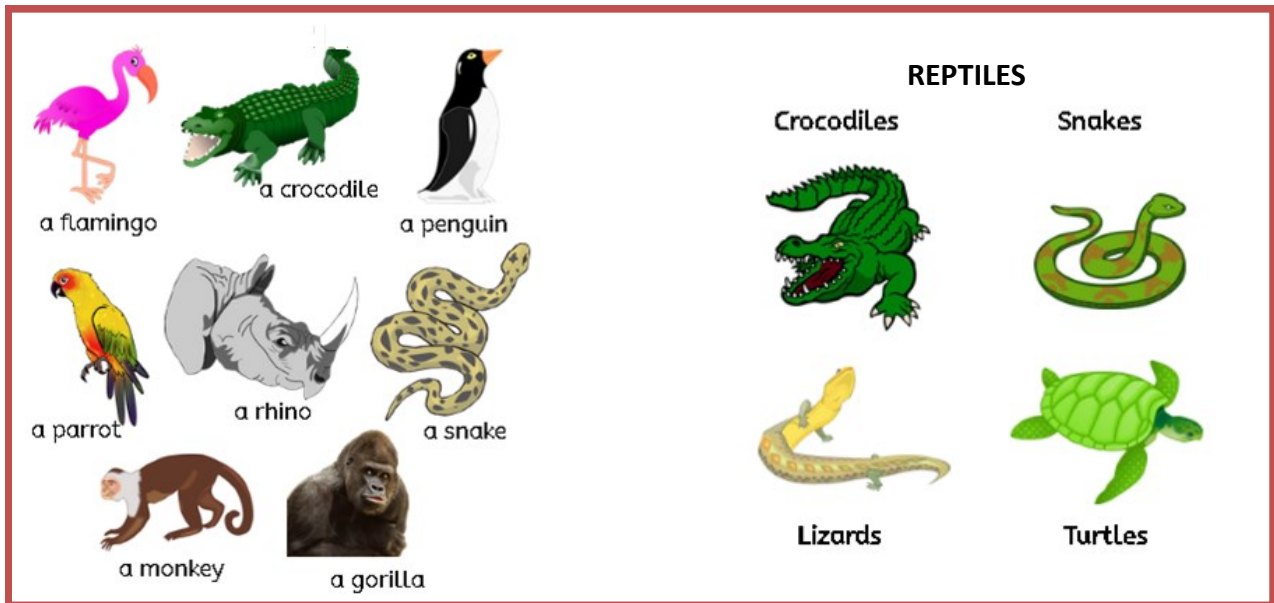
- 1- Sing Songs. Cantaredes cancións que xa todos e todas coñecedes e máis faredes actividades sobres as mesmas.

### **3. Learn More - Reptiles**

#### **REPTILES**

**Crocodiles** are the largest reptiles in the world. They can measure up to 20 metres. They can also be very dangerous. They are fast and strong and have lots of sharp teeth. Like all reptiles they live on land and in water.

**Snakes** have no arms or legs. They can be between 7 centimetres and 7 metres long. Some snakes are very dangerous and can kill people because they are venomous. The biggest snakes are anacondas and pythons. Like all reptiles they are cold-blooded.

**Lizards** are similar to snakes but they have four short legs. They also have long tails. They are very fast and lively. Some lizards are also very colourful. You can find lizards in the desert. Like all reptiles they lay eggs when they have babies.

**Turtles** move very slowly. They have a big shell on their backs. This helps to protect them from other animals. The oldest turtle in the world is 184 years old! Like all reptiles turtles lie in the sun to get energy.
